As we move into our summer schedule at church and many of you take trips to visit family and friends, be careful. Have a great summer. Relax, and be ready to start anew in


September with a new religious education study and choir program.

If you visit other churches, which I hope you do, while you are traveling bring me back a


bulletin from the church. No, I am not checking up on you to see if you went to church. I like to see other churches order of worship to see if there is something they are doing that we could do in Salado.



Summer Bible Study To Start June 30

"Celebrating Sabbath," our summer Bible study, will start on June 30 at 11:30 AM in the church's classroom. It is the just released 2022-2023 Bible study from Presbyterian Women & Horizons Magazine. The author is the Reverend Dr. Carol Bechtel, professor of Old Testament at Western Theological Seminary in Holland, Michigan. She also wrote the PW Bible study for 2008 and 2009. All members and friends of this congregation are welcome to receive the study book, even if it is not possible to attend.

For three past summers, members of the Presbyterian Church have of Salado used the PW yearly study during the summer, as a transitional activity between the adult Bible studies offered in the spring and fall. There are nine lessons, and this year we will continue to meet weekly on Thursdays after chair

yoga, with a brief "bring your own lunch" social time before beginning the lesson.

The author's introduction presents the Sabbath as a gift to God's people, one that can change our individual lives for the better. She encourages participants, as we study together, to open our minds, let go of preconceived ideas, and endeavor to *embrace the Sabbath* as a way of marking time in our lives. Each lesson focuses on a specific set of Scripture and a key idea related to that reading. *The nine topics feature "Sabbath and", including Celebration, Creation, Sunday, Surrender, Servitude, Hospitality, Self-Care, Justice, and Community.* Each lesson has an appropriate page of art which enhances the lesson topic, but the artwork is from nine different artists this year. There are study guides for the lessons, also helpful especially to anyone who can't attend the class.

Treasurer's Report - Pat Hart

Although second quarter collections totaled less than last year at this time, cash flow remains fine. Our church's 2022 gift to the One Great Hour of Sharing reached \$1,000 higher than last year's donation, and our check has been sent to Grace Presbytery. The \$3,000 annual pledge to the Presbytery has been paid. Also, an issue with TXU, the church's electricity provider, regarding missing bills this spring has been resolved. Pat's report was accepted as presented.

Committee Reports

Worship - Jeanette West – Regarding pulpit supply, two of the pastor's ordained friends, Jesse Thornton and MariLyn Jones, have graciously assisted him. Some choir members may perform "special music" during the summer months. We may resume 5th Sunday speakers in July and October.

Education - Mike Hart – "Celebrating Sabbath" will be summer Bible study. It will be led by Pat Rehm and begin on June 30 and end on August 25. The Adult Sunday School Class will recess for summer on June 5. The Men's Tuesday Prayer Group completed the books of *Genesis* and *James* so far this year and is currently studying *Matthew*.

Building and Grounds - Randy Kemp - This year has been uneventful but mowing and gardening are resuming now.

Fellowship - Shay VanWinkle - The luncheon following the memorial service for Julie was well attended, and many comments of appreciation were received. The beginning of fall classes usually has a luncheon "kick-off" in late August.

Communications - Pete Stebbins - He has been keeping the congregation notified of relevant information between the monthly *Messengers*.

Benevolence - Mike Hart - Our church's response to the OGHS was outstanding. The 1st quarter benevolent distributions totaled \$9,935, or 17 percent of all congregational giving so far this year. A new recipient of \$500 is Faith & Practice, an agency started by local doctors who help those in need here and abroad. One of this agency's leaders is Bob Schull, a Salado resident and physician and who has been attending our Tuesday Morning Prayer Group.

Personnel/Finance - Debby Aldridge - The 2021 church's financial records were audited by Debby Aldridge and Randy Kemp on March 13, 2022.
